1. Location:

3. Eligibility

Open to all EC-12 registered with the class (www.ec12.org) are invited to participate by the Chesapeake Bay Model Racing Association in the Annapolis EC-12 Regatta. All participants must be members of the EC-12 Class. All boats entering must be class legal and are subject to measurement and inspection at the discretion of the race Committee.

4. Pre-registration/Entry Fee

All participants must pre-register for this Regatta by completing an Entry Form or On-Line Entry and submitting it to the Committee for receipt no later than Thursday September 22nd.

Each entry shall be accompanied by the entry fee.

5. On-site Check-in

Check in will be at the park Saturday October 1st, 2016 during the times listed in the schedule.

6. Housing

There are also numerous hotels in the area where sailors can stay. There is a Sleep Inn, Holiday Inn Express, Best Western and Hilton Garden Inn within 10 minutes of the pond. Additionally there are hotels on the west side of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge which may be less expensive than those on Kent Island.

7. Social Activities

A light breakfast of coffee and donuts will be provided Saturday and Sunday mornings. Lunch will also be provided Saturday and Sunday. To be sure we have enough food for all participants and guests, you are asked to indicate the number in your party for each meal on Entry Form.

8. Inclement Weather

It is the Committee's intention to race if it rains.

9. Driving Instructions to the Pond:

The pond is located on Private property at the intersection of RT 50 East and Warrington Farm Lane in Queenstown, MD. Turn right onto Warrington Farm Lane and proceed to the pond on your left. You will enter a private drive.

10. About the Pond:

This is a privately owned pond. It is a near perfect sailing venue for RC sailing with no trees surrounding the park. The shoreline is relatively flat on most sides of the sailing areas and we will provide a dry launching area. There is no shade around the pond, bring tents. There is no power available at the venue, so charge those batteries. There will be a port a pot on site.
